

Regenerating Class 2 Furcations



Tooth #18 presents a deep class two furcation
The bone graft material used was **Immediate Graft™** mixed
with **OsseoConduct™** βTCP Perio granules. The surgery performed
was the Inverted Periosteal Graft.



Result: The graft material is resorbed and the furcation is filled with vital bone.



Tooth #30 presents with a deep class two furcation
The bone graft material used was [Immediate Graft™](#) mixed
with [OsseoConduct™](#) β TCP Perio granules. The surgery performed
was the Inverted Periosteal Graft.



Result: The graft material is resorbed and the furcation is filled with vital bone.



Class 2 lingual furcation with lingual moat and distal angular defect

The bone graft material used was [Immediate Graft™](#) mixed with [OsseoConduct™](#) β TCP Perio granules. The surgery performed was the Inverted Periosteal Graft.



Result: The furcation closed with the majority of the lingual moat regenerated and fill of the distal angular defect.
